Please read the following notes carefully:

• St. Patrick's P.S., Eskra is delighted to be involved in a Forest School project delivered by the Northern Ireland Forest School Association and the Dufferin Foundation as part of the 'Learning Without Walls' initiative.

Forest School is an exciting and innovative educational experience that has been shown to be hugely beneficial to all those taking part.

**Year 3/4 and Year 7** pupils from the school will be participating in **Forest School Sessions** in our own school grounds, on the following dates:

Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 - Year 3/4 Tuesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2020 - Year 3/4 Tuesday, 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 - Year 7 Tuesday, 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 - Year 7

Each session will last approximately one hour and will take place outside. These sessions will include activities such as den building, camouflage games and exploring nature.

Please ensure pupils have wellington boots with 2 pairs of socks or stout footwear, waterproof coats and warm clothes.

These Forest School sessions will be delivered by the **Northern Ireland Forest School Association (NIFSA).** NIFSA is a local charity that has been set up to promote outdoor environmental education for children in Northern Ireland.
