- Homework should not be completed at 'afterschools'. It is important that you spend time helping your child with their homework with them and that your child can see an interest shown in their school work.
- Try to encourage your child to do a little each night, as opposed to it all in one night!
- Talk to your child about our value of Respect and how we can show respect to others, for our belongings and the environment.
- Please ensure your child practises their tricky word work every night.
