- The first week back after the Christmas holidays is normally a revision/consolidation week in school so activities for this week will be planned accordingly.
- Year 1/2: Remote Learning will be delivered by Mrs. Dobbs in Mrs. Taggart's absence. We welcome Mrs. Dobb's to our team and wish her every success and happiness. Mrs. Dobbs has organised a pack of work to get the pupils in Year 1/2 started. If the current closure is to continue, she hopes to deliver some of her remote learning through SeeSaw.
- Year 3/4: Children will be completing their Home Learning remotely this week through SeeSaw. Please ensure that your child logs into SeeSaw each day as new work will be posted up daily. An overview for the week and some additional information can be found on SeeSaw also. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact Mrs. Barrett via SeeSaw between the hours of 9am and 3.30pm. The work set is mainly revision, however any new topics will be explained further through use of links, video and messaging. Work will be marked and feedback provided on a daily basis also. Reading books will not be given home this week, however, Mrs. Barrett would encourage each child to continue to read daily. Please have a look at some of the additional links added on SeeSaw and continue to use Mathletics
- Year 5/6: A pack has been sent home containing materials and books. Please return all books and completed work to school on Thursday, 7th January between 3pm and 6pm for marking.
- **Year 7:** A combination of books and on-line learning will be used. All information and activities are available through Microsoft Teams and on the Home Learning section of our school website. Please return all books and completed work to school by **Thursday, 7th January** no later than **6pm** for marking/feedback purposes.
- Pupils are expected to complete work regularly throughout the week.
- Pupils participating in on-line learning are expected to communicate appropriately
