- Pupils who are in school are participating in 'supervised learning.' Please be aware that this is not the same as normal classroom teaching and class teachers are not available for teaching or one to one support as they are preparing remote learning and marking/providing feedback. Pupils in school are asked to complete the same work as those who are at home, however, we have a limited number of computers so this will have to be kept under constant review for those pupils completing on-line tasks. Any work not completed in school should be finished at home.
- I am delighted to inform you **AB Coaching** will be delivering remote **PE Zoom** sessions every Friday over the lockdown. This will be paid for through Well-Being funding that the school has received recently.

Sessions will be at the following times:

Years 1-4: 9.30am to 10.30am.

Years 5-7: 1.30pm to 2.30pm.

• In order to improve the emotional health and well-being of our whole school community (pupils, parents, staff and beyond) during this challenging time, we have decided to give each day of the week a well-being theme as follows:
