How you can help at home!



- Talk to your child about the meaning of kindness—how can we show kindness to our friends and family.
- Ask your child can they name any of their new class mates. Tell your child why their name was given to them— are they named after a grandparent, an auntie,etc? This will help with class discussions later.

Encourage your child to wash their hands before meals, after they use the toilet &

talk to your child about the importance of flushing the toilet and general hygiene.
