- Encouraging the highest standards of handwriting and presentation of work.
- Helping your child to learn any new words and their meanings from their Dictionary Book. (See Spelling folder.)
- Revising number and language facts each night from your child's Tables And Grammar Rules book.
- Reciting x2 to x12 multiplication and division tables together.
- Helping your child to research using books, the Internet, NewsDesk, etc.
- Encouraging your child to exercise regularly.
- Helping your child to identify members of their support network.
- Encouraging your child to talk about their worries and fears.
- Praying together.
- Looking at the layout and language of informal letters.
- Helping your child to prepare for Confirmation.
- **Helping your child to think for themselves, solve everyday problems and make decisions.**
